Jill Baker is the Superintendent of Schools for the Long Beach Unified School District. Prior to her appointment as Superintendent, she worked for 28 years at LBUSD as a successful teacher, principal, and central office administrator.

Dr. Baker enjoys multiple connections with local organizations, foundations, and universities, all of which continue to support efforts in the school district. She also serves on two non-profit boards that support the community.

In 2005, Dr. Baker completed her tenure as a fellow in the Broad Urban Superintendents Academy. She earned her doctorate in educational leadership at the University of Southern California in 2004, master's degree in school administration at California State University, Long Beach in 1998, and her bachelor's degree in sociology at University of California, Irvine in 1991.
