Why We Exist

For most low-income, first-generation students in Long Beach, the dream of not only attending but also graduating from college is never realized.

Nationally, only 9% of low-income students earn a bachelor's degree by their mid-20s compared to 77% of high-income peers*. Over 80% are considered 'very low-income' according to federal income guidelines. And 22% of low-income students who were college-intending never show up. Additionally, low-income is not just a financial constraint to get into college but also limits the students' ability to prepare themselves to get accepted and excel once they are in college.

At Operation Jump Start we are addressing the issues that are preventing these lowincome first-generation students from getting their college degrees through programs and mentoring that enable these students to achieve educational opportunities they never thought possible.

Our Programs

College Access

College Access equips students starting in the 8th grade with resources and continues to guide them on the path to college readiness for the next three years. This is realized through individualized academic advising, support, year-round enrichment programming, and one-onone mentoring. Students are matched with volunteer mentors to provide positive role models actively involved in the community. Mentors guide and assist our students to achieve their educational, social, and personal goals.

College Success

College Success provides enhanced support to students beginning in the 11th grade through college attainment. Students learn how to navigate barriers first-generation college students face in higher education. In this program, our youth receive college and financial aid application assistance, as well as support workshops, peer-to-peer partnerships, and case management sessions that address the transitions that accompany college. The program also provides social-emotional support by equipping students with a counselor (MSW intern) for each academic year while they are in college.
